The Bangladesh Cricket Board (BCB) invites Expression of Interest (EOI) along with financial offers from reputed business houses / companies / parties / agencies for the **TITLE SPONSORSHIP AND GROUND BRANDING RIGHTS** of **National Cricket League (NCL)** for the next 03 seasons, i.e. 21<sup>st</sup> NCL (2019-2020), 22<sup>nd</sup> NCL (2020-2021) & 23<sup>rd</sup> NCL (2021-2022).

## **NON-ELIGIBILITY :**

01. Companies related to Tobacco, Alcohol (surrogated and non-surrogated), Betting, online betting shall not be eligible to participate in the EOI.
02. Any person(s) or entities with an existing unresolved dispute with BCB or ICC on a point of law or fact shall be ineligible to acquire the aforementioned rights or to participate in the EOI.

The EOI along with financial offer must be submitted to the BCB Management Office at Sher-e-Bangla National Cricket Stadium, Mirpur-2, Dhaka 1216, Bangladesh by the close of business hours on **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2019** in a sealed envelope addressed to the "Chief Executive Officer, BCB".

The following documents must be submitted along with the EOI and financial offer :

01. Bank Solvency Certificate along with Bank Statement.
02. Updated Trade License Copy.
03. VAT Registration Certificate.
04. TIN Certificate.
05. Company Profile and Individual Directors' / Owners' Profile.
06. Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association along with Certificate of Incorporation and Schedule-X.
07. In case of Consortium Notarized consortium Agreement.
08. Updated financial audit report (in case of consortium each members' financial audit report needs to be submitted individually).

Further, also reserves the right to cancel the entire EOI process and / or modify, add or alter the terms of the document and / or the conditions for EOI by issuing an addendum(s) at any time prior to the submission of the EOI.
