Official Partnership Rights

The Governing Council (GC) of Bangladesh Premier League (BPL) T20 tournament hereby invites full proposal from the reputed business houses/ companies/parties/agencies for the Official Partnership Rights for Bangabandhu Bangladesh Premier League (BBPL) T20 tournament 2019 i.e. 01 (one) edition/season only covering the following:

- 1. Official Beverage Partner (Carbonated Beverage Only).
- 2. Official Drink Partner (Mineral Water Only).
- 3. Official Ice Cream Selling Partner.

Non-Eligibility:

- Companies related to Tobacco, Alcohol (surrogated and non-surrogated), Betting, online betting shall not be eligible to participate in the EOI Process.
- ii) Any person(s) or entities / companies with an existing unresolved dispute (i.e. Financial, Disciplinary and/or any other) with BCB or ICC on a point of law or fact shall be ineligible to acquire the aforementioned rights or to participate in the EOI Process.

- a) Bank Solvency Certificate along with Bank Statement.
- b) Updated Trade License Copy.
- c) Updated VAT Registration Certificate.
- d) TIN Certificate.
- e) Company Profile and Individual Directors' / Owners' Profile.
- f) Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association along with Certificate of Incorporation and Schedule-X.
- g) In case of Consortium Notarized consortium Agreement.
- h) Updated financial audit report (in case of consortium each members' financial audit report needs to submitted individually).
